A Missional Community is a **Family of Missionary Servants** sent as Disciples who make Disciples.

WHY MISSIONAL COMMUNITIES? They are:

- A primary apologetic of the gospel. - John 13:34-35
- The primary organizing structure of the church. - Acts 2:42-47
- The most effective way to make disciples, because they provide context for:
 - » Life on life
 - » Life in community
 - » Life on mission

RHYTHMS: How we live everyday life together with gospel intentionality

- **Story-formed:** Gospel-centered (Creation > Fall > Redemption > Restoration)
- **Listen:** *UP* to God (circle), *IN* to Family, *OUT* to our missionary context
- **Eat:** Centered around our common-union in Christ and His mission
- **Celebrate:** Parties, birthdays, holidays, life and God’s goodness toward us
- **Recreate:** Rest and work (semi-circle)
- **Bless:** We are blessed to be a blessing to others.
